Feature fact sheet

MarshBook brings permit bookings, membership, club documents, bag returns and season administration into one clear online system designed around the needs of UK wildfowling clubs.

Customisable digital membership card

Every member can access a personalised card showing their name, membership number, class, live status and expiry. Each club can customise the card title, logo, colour and footer wording. Members can view it on a phone, print it or save a copy, and it updates automatically from their current profile.

Features for members

- Secure member access Self-registration, committee approval, secure sign-in and password reset.	- At-a-glance dashboard Membership number, booking status, upcoming flights and actions that need attention.
- Live permit availability See available, limited and full dates by permit area and flight.	- Online permit booking Choose the ground, flight and date, add vehicle, guest and booking details, then submit online.
- Automatic rules checks MarshBook checks booking windows, capacity, blocked dates, conflicts, vehicle requirements and outstanding returns.	- Approval and notifications Permits can be issued automatically or routed for approval, with the member kept informed.
- Booking management Review current and historic bookings, open confirmations and cancel eligible future bookings.	- Useful flight information Permit confirmations can include area details, what3words links, sunrise, sunset and tide times.
- Digital membership card A personalised, printable card showing live member details, class, status and expiry.	- Club documents View or download the latest documents made available to the member's membership class.
- Online bag returns Record species, numbers, shots fired, party size and visit notes after a flight.	- Return history Review submitted returns for the current season and see when a return is outstanding.
- Permit area maps Browse club grounds and open accurate what3words location links.	- Vehicle self-service Members can keep their own vehicle registration details current.
- Bird identification tests Take a private, committee-led bird identification test through the member account.	- Works across devices Responsive browser access on phones, tablets and computers without requiring a mobile app.

Feature availability and wording can be configured to suit each club's rules and operating practices.



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Features for club administrators

A single committee workspace for day-to-day member support, permit control, reporting and the end-of-season jobs that otherwise live across inboxes and spreadsheets.

- Member records Create, approve, update and search member profiles and linked user accounts.	- Membership classes Configure classes and use them to control access to relevant documents and processes.
- Renewals and expiry Manage renewal status, expiry dates and classes or identities that do not expire.	- Member data movement Export member data and use templates and import tools when bringing records into MarshBook.
- Roles and support access Control administrative roles and, where authorised, open the portal as a member to provide support.	- Audit and login records Review administrator activity and user login history.
- Permit area configuration Maintain grounds, conditions, mapping, what3words information, lease records and availability.	- Flexible flight rules Configure flight options, per-flight capacity, booking windows and area-specific species lists.
- Open and blocked dates Use seasonal ranges, exact opening dates, permitted weekdays and blocked dates.	- Conflict prevention Prevent incompatible bookings across linked grounds or flight periods.
- Approval workflows Choose automatic issue or approval, assign PIO responsibility and send decision notifications.	- Permit oversight View, create and manage permits, pending approvals and area-by-area issuance summaries.
- Privacy controls Control which authorised users may see permit-holder names in shared availability views.	- Bag return reporting Summarise returns and analyse activity by season, area, flight and species.
- Exports and trends Export detailed season data, trend analysis and previous-season information for committee or conservation use.	- Historical records Retain archived permits and import historical permit and bag-return information.
- Season administration Set global and area-specific seasons, close a season cleanly and prepare the next one.	- Backup and recovery tools Create, download and restore permit and return backups during season-end operations.
- Document publishing Upload club documents, organise document types and target access by membership class.	- Membership card branding Set each club's card title, logo, colour and footer wording from system settings.
- Bird test administration Create and proctor private bird identification test sessions and record results.	- System controls Configure club-wide settings and planned maintenance messages from the admin area.
